Holloway Neighbourhood Group runs a multi-purpose community centre - the Old Fire Station and a mental health service - the Stress Project, in Holloway Islington. We deliver services and form partnerships to reduce social isolation and improve wellbeing for local residents.

We have an exciting opportunity for an exceptional candidate to join our team of committed staff and volunteers, helping us to work flexibly to reach and support local residents in the context of fast-changing needs.

Older Men's Projects Worker £20,850 pro rata (1 day per week)

Maintaining telephone contact with isolated local men to keep them connected, outreach to engage more men, and leading a men's social activities club from our community centre, when it is safe to do so. The postholder must have prior experience of running inclusive groups and the ability to establish rapport with older men.
